

Overflow Vendor and Camping Information for the 2024 AMCA National Meet, Perkiomen Chapter from April 24th to 27th

Overflow vending and camping is available at the Reading Motorcycle Club located at 208 Jefferson Street, approx. 1 mile from the Fairgrounds.

- Overflow vendors and campers can start to come in on Wednesday the 24th.
- Hook-ups and dump stations are not available so you will need to be self-contained and dump your tanks elsewhere, and not on our grounds. There will be \$100 Fine assessed to anyone caught dumping on the grounds.
- Using generators is fine during the day or night.
- There are portable toilets around the club property for your use.
- There are no showers on the club property but it's possible that the showers at the Fairgrounds may be available for your use.
- Free shuttle bus service will be provided to and from the Fairgrounds.
- Pets must be on a leash and/or lead at all times. No exceptions. Please keep our ground clean and clean up after your pets.
- Absolutely no glass bottles
- Small campfires are allowed and must be contained within a fire ring. Please clean up upon your departure. (No nails, screw or burning of pallets). Fire Ring not provided.
- Below are the costs for the entire weekend event.
 - Vendors - \$65.00 with Electric \$80.00
 - Campers - \$40.00
 - Support/Bike trailers and Tents - \$20.00
 - General parking (Fairgrounds Overflow) - \$10.00

Here's some additional things taking place during the event at the club that are separate from the other costs.

- There will be a buffet dinner on Thursday night in the clubhouse @5pm.
- Old school ARM DROP motorcycle grudge racing is on Friday night under the lights and the cost is \$20 per person to race. Run as many times as you can on our 1/8th mile drag strip between 6-10pm.
- Friday night a band will be playing at the Club starting at 8pm going until midnight.
