

Overflow Vendor and Camping Information for the 2026 AMCA National Meet, Perkiomen Chapter from April 22nd to 25th

Overflow vending and camping is available at the Reading Motorcycle Club located at 208 Jefferson Street, approx. 1 mile from the Fairgrounds.

- Overflow vendors and campers can start to come in on Wednesday the 22nd.
- Hook-ups and dump stations are not available so you will need to be self-contained and dump your tanks elsewhere, and not on our grounds. There will be \$100 Fine assessed to anyone dumping on the grounds.
- Using generators is fine during the day or night.
- There are portable toilets around the club property for your use.
- There are no showers on the club property but it's possible that the showers at the Fairgrounds may be available for your use.
- Free shuttle bus service will be provided to and from the Fairgrounds.
- **Pets must be on a leash and/or lead at all times.** No exceptions. Please keep our ground clean and clean up after your pets. i.e. pets are not welcome to run free on the property.
- Absolutely no glass bottles
- Small campfires are allowed and must be contained within a fire ring. Please clean up upon your departure. (No nails, screw or burning of pallets). Fire Ring not provided.
- Below are the costs for the entire weekend event.
 - Vendors - \$65.00 with Electric \$80.00
 - Camping : Motorhomes / Travel Trailers / Truck with Trailer
 - Less Than 40 Feet = \$50
 - Greater Than 40 Feet = \$75
 - i.e. If your motorhome is 40 Feet and you are towing a trailer behind it that is 16 feet, you are greater than 40 feet.
 - There are now designated spaces for greater than 40 feet.
 - Support/Bike trailers and Tent Camping - \$20.00
 - Weekend General parking (Fairgrounds Overflow) - \$20.00
- Anyone in violation of not following the guidelines will be subject to being asked to leave the property.
